The Bombay  
Prohibition  
Act, 1949

No. MIS 1107/CR-33(1)/EXC-3.- Whereas the Government of Maharashtra considers that the following rules further to amend the Bombay Foreign Liquor and Rectified Spirit (Transport Fee) Rules, 1954 ( hereinafter referred to as "Principal Rules") should be brought into force at once, and, therefore, the rules should be made without previous publication as provided by the proviso to sub-section (3) of section 143 of the Bombay Prohibition Act, 1949, (Bom. XXV of 1949);

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b), (f) and (u) of sub-section (2) read with the proviso to sub-section (3) of section 143 of the Bombay Prohibition Act, 1949 (Bom. XXV of 1949); and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Government of Maharashtra is pleased to make the following rules, further to amend the Bombay Foreign Liquor and Rectified Spirit (Transport Fees) Rules, 1954, namely :-


1. These rules may be called the Bombay Foreign Liquor and Rectified Spirit (Transport Fees) (Second Amendment) Rules, 2007.
2. In rule 4 of the Bombay Foreign Liquor and Rectified Spirit (Transport Fees) Rules, 1954, under the heading " Rates of Special Fee", for clause (i) and (ii) the following clause shall be substituted, namely :-

"(i) (a) 200% of the Assessable value or Rs. 300/- per Bulk Liter whichever is higher for the Spirit having Assessable value upto Rs. 1,000/- per case of 9 B.L.

(b) 150% of the Assessable value or Rs. 300/- per Bulk Liter whichever is higher for the Spirit having Assessable value more than Rs. 1,000/- & upto Rs. 2,000/- per case of 9 B.L.

- (c) 100% of the Assessable value or Rs. 300/- per Bulk Liter whichever is higher for the Spirit having Assessable value more than Rs.2,000/- & upto Rs. 5,000/- per case of 9 B.L.
- (d) 75% of the Assessable value or Rs. 300/- per Bulk Liter whichever is higher for the Spirit having Assessable value more than Rs. 5,000/- per case of 9 B.L.
- (ii) 200% of the Assessable value or Rs. 200/- per Bulk Liter whichever is higher, for wine either in bottle or in bulk.
