CIRCULAR

Sub: Extension of licence period for sale of liquor under L-1 & L-1F licence expiring on 31.03.2011.

In accordance with the provision of sub rule 2 of Rule 34 of Delhi excise Rules,2010, the Competent Authority has approved the extension of validity of existing L-1 & L-1F licences for the sale of Liquor brands (L-1 & L-1F Licences holder) registered as per the terms and conditions during 2010-11 at their existing price upto 30.04.2011.

The L-1 & L-1F licencees who are willing to avail this extended period of one month from 01.04.2011 to 30.04.2011 to make sales of their registered brands at existing price, are required to deposit one month's fee i.e. Licence fee, Brand fee, Brand Registration fee, BWH fee and any/all other fee as applicable to L-1 & L-1F Licencees on pro-rata basis for a period of one month in advance.

However, any person holding such non-renewable licence, shall not be under any obligation to accept such offer to extend his licence.
